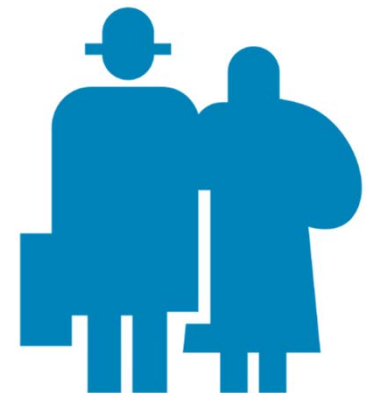

“If you have uncontrolled immigration, you have uncontrolled pressure on public services.”

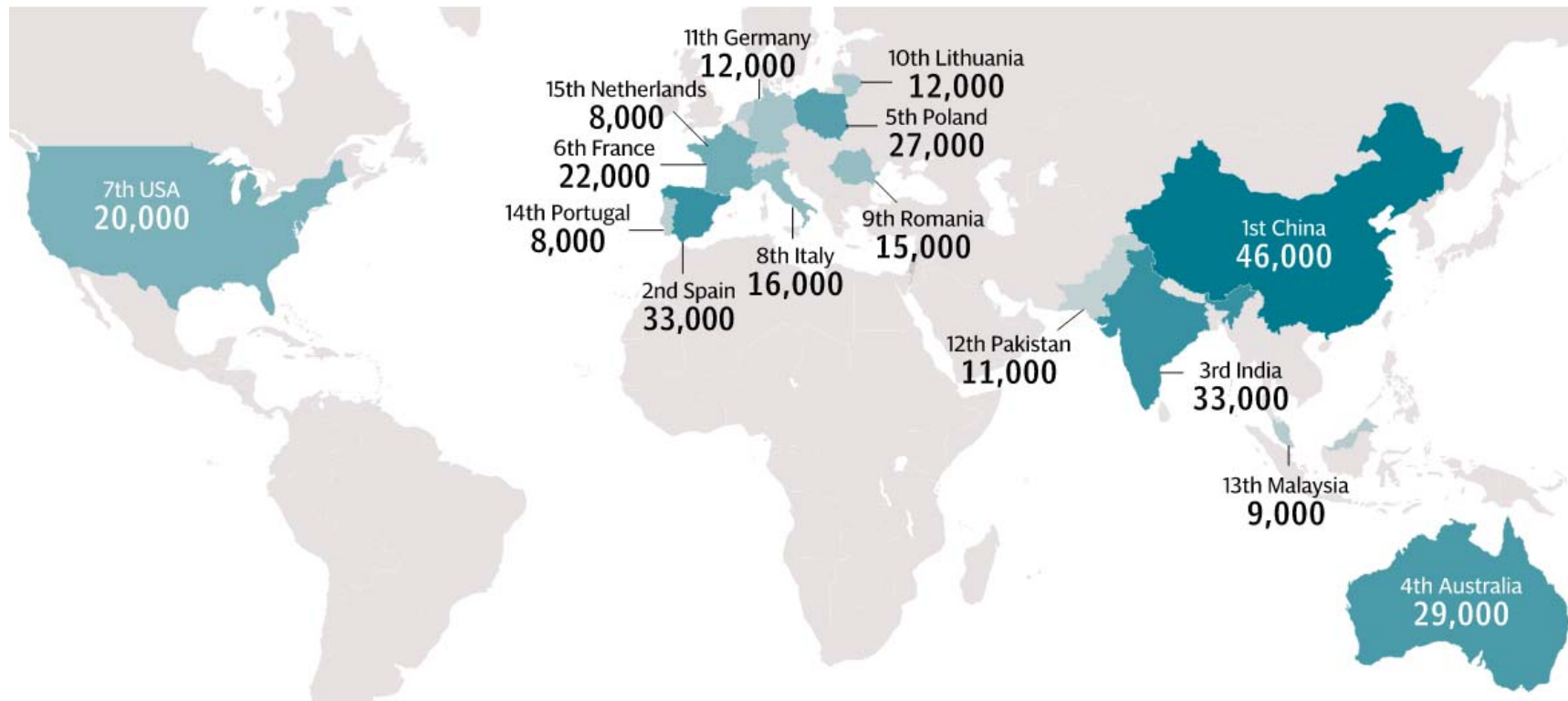
Immigrant Structure



641,000 people came to Britain in 2014

Two thirds of them are non-EEA immigrants

WHERE ARE THE IMMIGRANTS TO THE UK FROM?



KEY FIGURES

Between 2001-2011

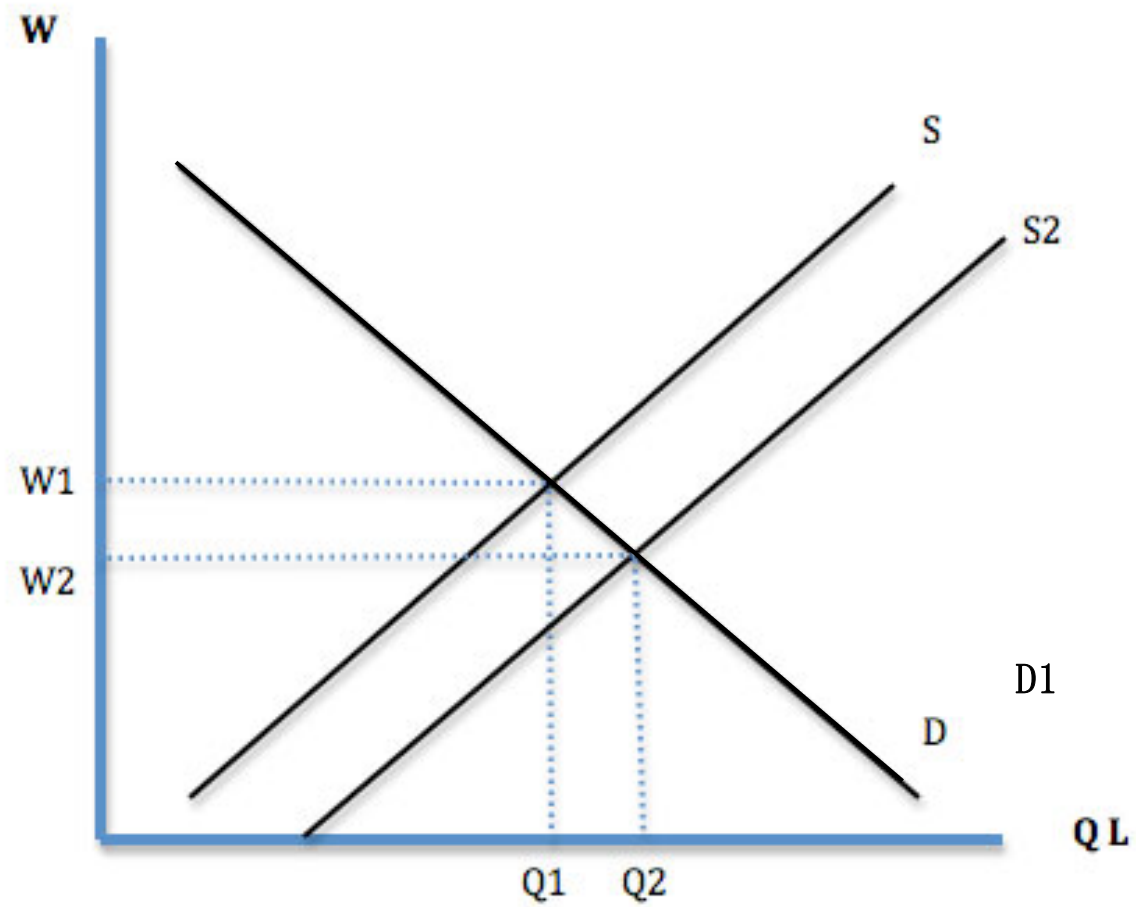
- EEA immigrants contributed 34% more in taxes than they received in benefits and services
- Non-EEA immigrants, 32%

Between 1995-2011

- Each EEA immigrant put about £6,000 more into public purse
- Non-EEA immigrant took about £21,000 more than they put
- Native Briton, £11,000
